The NSW Sports Safety Awards are coordinated by the NSW Sporting Injuries Committee on behalf of the State Government to recognise and reward outstanding achievement in the research and prevention of sports related injuries and the adoption of safe sport practices.

These awards are exclusive to New South Wales.

The NSW Sporting Injuries Committee is a non-profit state government organisation established in 1978 to provide affordable insurance and to promote safe sport practices within the sporting community.

The Committee has held the annual NSW Sports Safety Awards since 1998.

AWARDS

Gold, silver and bronze trophies will be awarded in the Education and Promotion and Implementation and Adoption award categories together with vouchers to purchase sports equipment up to the value of \$2,000.

The FE Johnson Memorial Fellowship carries a prize of \$20,000, the David Garlick Memorial Scholarship \$10,000 and the Team Research Award \$2,000.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

- Nominations for research awards will be accepted from any member of the research team or the institution of learning.
- Education and Promotion and Implementation and Adoption award nominations will be accepted from any government agency, sporting organisation, school, or any institution, organisation or agency involved with sports injury prevention and/or reduction in NSW.
- Nominations will only be accepted on the nomination form.
- Information to support your nomination such as videos, CDs, DVDs, photographs or letters of commendation should be attached.
- Endorsement from your regional or state governing body is encouraged.

ASSESSMENT

A panel comprising representatives from the NSW Sporting Injuries Committee, Department of Sport and Recreation, Department of Education and Training, NSW Sports Federation and an independent panel member/s will assess nominations. The panel will take into consideration the quality, impact and results of the nominated project in assessing the nomination. The Fellowship and Scholarship are awarded on individual merit.

The awards will be presented at a celebratory function on Friday 18th November 2011 at Homebush.
